Comment

The aging and soon-to-be-replaced Trafic is poorly equipped, even by the standards of the commercial van sector. Autonomous emergency braking (AEB) and forward collision warning (FCW) are not available, even as an option. No lane support is provided.

For speed assistance, the Trafic has a driver-set speed limiter as an option but no speed limit information system. A seatbelt reminder is standard equipment for the driver's seat but is not offered, even as an option, on the passenger seat.
